SUBJECT: Verification of Portland General Electric (PGE) Schedule 129 Transition Cost Adjustment Rate Tariff Sheets, Effective September 1, 2019. Supplemental Filing of Advice No. 19-14, and Compliance Filing Advice No. 19-17.

In Order No. 19-277 entered August 28, 2019, in Docket No. UE 365, (The Order) the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) required PGE to update its tariff sheets with corrected values. In response to The Order, PGE submitted Supplemental Filing of Advice No. 19-14 which provided corrected indicative values; and Compliance Filing Advice No. 19-17 which established final values. The filings comply with the Commission's decision in UE 365.

Staff finds the attached tariff sheets filed by the Company to be true and accurate representations of the agreement entered into by parties and confirmed by Commission Order No. 19-277.

No major changes to verbiage or meaning were made to the tariffs. The changes made were commensurate with normal updates to power costs and loads which occur annually.

The checks and analytic tasks required to affirm the accuracy of rates included the following:

- Confirm that the prices contained in the filed Tariffs conform to those agreed upon in the UE 365 Stipulation and ultimately approved by the Commission.
- Confirm that all date, revision numbers, and other minor changes are correct and proper.

Staff verified that the specific impacts authorized by The Order will be achieved by the tariff pages as filed.
