RE: LC 67 and LC 70 – PacifiCorp's 2017 Integrated Resource Plan and 2019 Integrated Resource Plan

The Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) issued Order No. 18-138 in docket LC 67, PacifiCorp's 2017 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) on April 27, 2018. As part of that order, the Commission directed PacifiCorp to perform additional analysis of unit-by-unit coal retirement scenarios. This additional analysis was directed by the Commission to be completed and provided to the Commission and parties in docket LC 67 by June 30, 2018. PacifiCorp will complete this analysis by the June 30, 2018 deadline and provide the results of the analysis to parties in docket LC 67. PacifiCorp provides this letter to clarify how PacifiCorp will provide the analysis to the Commission and to parties.

In addition to providing the analysis to parties in docket LC 67, PacifiCorp will present the analysis at its 2019 IRP June 2018 public input meeting. Specifically, the analysis will be presented at a confidential work session on June 28, 2018, and consistent with the protective orders in place in LC 67 and LC 70¹, the confidential work session can be attended by stakeholders that have signed the protective order in *either* LC 67 or LC 70. Similarly, copies of the confidential presentation materials will be available to stakeholders that have signed the protective order in *either* LC 67 or LC 70. Finally, consistent with the Commission's IRP guidelines and PacifiCorp's long-standing IRP process, stakeholders will have the opportunity to participate in the development of the 2019 IRP and will have the ability to request information from PacifiCorp. PacifiCorp notes that the protective order in place for LC 67 is the same as the protective order in LC 70.

PacifiCorp appreciates the importance of stakeholder engagement in its IRP process. Although the analysis required by the Commission in LC 67 is new, PacifiCorp's process for robust, open and transparent stakeholder engagement has not changed.
