In Order No. 23-047 (Order) entered February 17, 2023, in Docket No. UE 399, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) addressed just the second phase of this general rate case, restricted to consideration of the Fourth Partial Stipulation (Stipulation) regarding PacifiCorp's Accelerated Commitment Tariff (ACT). The Commission in its Order adopted the Stipulation in its entirety and dismissed the objections of New Sun Energy, LLC (NewSun). As a result, the Company's revenue requirement is still set to increase by \$49.2 million, about 4 percent, or \$46.7 million or 3.7 percent on a net basis including the impact of updates to adder rates. For a typical residential customer using 900 kWh a month, the change in total bill is \$7.94, and represents an 8.6 percent increase. These values are unchanged from work papers earlier filed by the Company in this general rate case.

In response to the Order, PacifiCorp submitted its Compliance Filing Advice No. 23-005 on February 24, 2023 with updates to index and four new tariff pages in Schedule 273. ACT Original Sheet Nos.: 273-1, 273-2, 273-3 and 273-4.

Staff has reviewed the Advice Filing and finds it complies with the Commission's Order.

Staff recommends that an acknowledgement letter be sent, and the tariff sheets as currently filed be allowed to go into effect for service rendered on and after March 1, 2023.
