Please provide a complete copy of the Company's hedging policy (both gas and electric) as of May 2007 and any subsequent revision.

Response:

PGE's power purchase strategy has three components: (1) near-term, (2) mid-term, and (3) long-term. The near-term window consists of the next 24-month period. The mid-term window covers years 3 through 5. The long-term strategy covers purchases beyond the next five-year period. The following three items address PGE's purchase strategy:

- 1) Near-Term The Energy Risk Management Policies & Procedures ("ERMP&P") provide details of the approval process for power supply transactions entered into by PGE and sets specific position limits for months 1-24 (see Appendix C). The 2007 and 2011 versions of PGE's ERMP&P are provided as Attachment 006-A.
- 2) Mid-Term The Mid-Term Strategy (MTS) was developed as a policy in 2006 with presentations to PGE's Board of Directors and the Oregon Public Utility Commission prior to its execution. Copies of those presentations are provided as Attachment 006-B.

3) Long-Term – The Integrated Resource Plan addresses long-term acquisitions.
