COMMUNITY ENERGY PROJECT'S REQUEST FOR UP-FRONT PARTIAL PAYMENT OF HB 2475 CASE FUND GRANT

Pursuant to Order No. 23-033 (approving Environmental Justice Funding Agreement for HB 2475 Intervenor Funding), Section 7 of the Environmental Justice Communities Funding Agreement and OAR 860-001-0890(5), Community Energy Project (CEP), submits this request for pre-completion partial payment of the case fund grant awarded pursuant to Order No. 24-072 in the amount of \$25,000. CEP has conferred with Idaho Power Company's counsel, Lisa Nordstrom, who advised that the company has no objection to this request.

The above referenced rule and Agreement authorize up to one-half of the grant award to be paid prior to completion of the activities stated in the approved budget and described scope of work and expenses. The up-front payment allows for and will be used in this case for reimbursement or payment of expenses as the case proceeds, which conserves effort and resources by reducing the number of times CEP will have to itemize the expenses, payees and
