Pursuant to OAR 860-039-0055(2), PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power, and Mr. Craig A Soule, net metering customer, have agreed to a new 12-month annualized billing period. OAR 860-039-0055(2) requires that the annual billing cycle for net metering customers end at the end of the March billing month each year, unless the utility and net metering customer agree to a different annual billing cycle.
