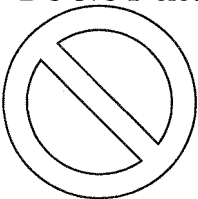

**RE: RE XX—Waiver of billing adjustments for economic reasons**

On June 24, 2014, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) issued Order No. 14-230, adopting changes to rules regarding adjustments to utility bills as a result of under- or overbilling. As part of that order, the Commission ordered utilities that waive a billing adjustment for economic reasons to file an annual report documenting the waivers and providing the basis for the waiver. The annual reports required by the Commission in the event of a utility waiver of a billing adjustment for economic reasons are due “one year from the date of [Order No. 14-230],” that is, June 24, 2015.

Pacific Power tracks and reviews adjustments on a monthly basis and agents are trained in adjusting bills in accordance with OAR 860-021-0135. For the twelve month period ended May 2015, Pacific Power did not waive a billing adjustment for economic reasons. Therefore, Pacific Power does not intend to file an annual report as set forth in Order No. 14-230.
