Dear Ms. Bailey-Goggins:

Citizens Telecommunications Company of Oregon d/b/a Frontier Communications of Oregon (Frontier) hereby submits for filing the original and a redlined copy of the revised tariff sheets.

The purpose of this filing is to increase the rate for Business Caller ID, Caller ID with Name and Number and Voice Mail services. The current rates for these services have not been adjusted in over three years. Frontier believes the proposed rate increases are representative of the current market price for these services.

The proposed rate increases are anticipated to yield an annual increase of \$4,750.56 and will impact approximately 329 Business customers. A revenue impact analysis is included in Attachment A.

Customers are being notified 45 days prior to the rate increase by a direct mailer notice. A copy of the customer notice is included in Attachment B.

It is respectfully requested that this filing become effective on July 4, 2006.

To reflect current market conditions, Frontier proposes the following adjustments to business calling feature rates.
