Northwest Natural Gas Company, dba NW Natural (NW Natural or Company), files herewith the following revision to its Tariff, P.U.C. Or. 25, stated to become effective with service on and after <u>January 1, 2018</u>:

Sixth Revision of Sheet 301-1, Schedule 301, "Public Purposes Funding Surcharge."

The purpose of this filing is to revise the portion of public purpose funds allocated to Energy Trust of Oregon (Energy Trust) for the administration of residential and commercial energy efficiency programs from 3.20% to 3.59%. This change will ensure that Energy Trust of Oregon (Energy Trust) will have approximately \$22.0 million dollars of total program funding in 2018, which is sufficient to acquire nearly 4.1 million therm savings.

This filing will result in a total public purpose charge of 4.89% applied to Residential bills and 4.14% applied to Commercial bills. The effect of this filing is to increase the average residential bill by about \$0.19 per month and the average commercial bill by about \$0.78 per month

Attached are worksheets demonstrating the calculation of the rate, the impact this will have on customer bills, and a worksheet from Energy Trust detailing their funding requirements for 2018.

A request for approval on less than statutory notice is included with this filing. NW Natural submitted comments to Energy Trust on November 17, 2017 regarding concerns about administrative costs and administrative cost allocation. The timing of the budget process did not allow for the comments to be addressed prior to the time required for the minimum statutory notice of this filing. NW Natural now understands that a meeting will occur in January 2018 to review concerns regarding the allocation of administrative costs covered by NW Natural ratepayer public purpose funds.
