Suspension of Schedule 70, Appliance Recycling Program

Attention Filing Center:

Idaho Power Company ("Idaho Power" or "Company") hereby submits this tariff advice filing requesting suspension of Schedule 70, Appliance Recycling Program (the "Program"). Idaho Power's request is based on receipt of notice that Idaho Power's appliance recycling contractor, a 20-year industry partner operating in 28 states, has abruptly closed its business and is subject to a court-ordered receivership. As of the date of entry of the receivership order, November 18, 2015, the contractor did not have sufficient funds to satisfy its financial obligations, and the receiver is currently attempting to address the same. Accordingly, Idaho Power requests suspension of the Program until the Company determines whether there is another cost-effective option to continue the Program.

Idaho Power respectfully requests suspension of the Program effective December 16, 2016. Because this filing is not within the 30 days statutory notice, a L.S.N. is also included.

SCHEDULE 70 APPLIANCE RECYCLING PROGRAM (SUSPENDED)

AVAILABILITY

This program is available to residential Customers living in single and multi-family residences, including manufactured and modular homes, who remove and recycle a refrigerator or freezer and who live within the Company's service territory within the State of Oregon. Service will not be available to some geographic areas during winter months due to road conditions. Service to these areas will resume after April 1. A list of areas where service is unavailable is on the Idaho Power web site.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Appliance Recycling Program is a program designed to encourage the removal and recycling of less efficient appliances by providing a removal service from the home and recycling of the appliance at no cost to Customers. To participate, Customers will schedule an appointment by phone or on the Idaho Power web site to have their unit collected. The unit will be picked up from the Customer's home, transported, dismantled and recycled. Idaho Power will also provide, free of charge, two light emitting diode (LED) bulbs per customer at the time of unit pick up to encourage participation. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By participating in the Program, Customers will be subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Functioning units only.
- Secondary units are preferred but the program is available for the replacement of a primary unit.
- 3. Unit must be residential grade, 10 to 30 cubic feet, and must be empty at time of pick up.
- 4. Clear path of removal must exist.
- 5. Maximum participation of two units per Customer, per year.
- 6. The customer will receive two free LED bulbs at the time of pick up.
