RE: Second Supplemental Filing of Advice No. 20-14, Schedule 300 Line Extension Allowance

Portland General Electric Company (PGE) submits this filing pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 757.205 and 757.210 and Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 860-022-0025 for filing proposed tariff sheets associated with Tariff P.U.C. No. 18. PGE initially filed Advice No. 20-14 on June 8, 2020 with a requested effective date of January 1, 2021. PGE then submitted a Supplemental Filing on August 20, 2020, to add clarifying language. PGE now submits this Supplemental Filing to extend the effective date from January 1, 2021 to February 1, 2021.

PGE still requests that Advice No. 20-14, Schedule 300 Line Extension Allowance (LEA) still be considered for approval at the December 15, 2020 public meeting. Securing an early approval will allow the proposed LEA time to be implemented into PGE's billing system.

All sheets remain as previously filed.

To satisfy the requirements of OAR 860-022-0025(2), PGE provides the following responses:

OAR 860-022-0025 requires that PGE submit a statement of the tariff schedule change, the number of customers affected, the change in revenue, and the grounds supporting the change. The number of customers affected is unknown and this doesn't increase or decrease customer prices.
