**RE: Third Supplemental Filing of Advice No. 21-11 Schedule 55 Large
Nonresidential Green Energy Affinity Rider (GEAR)**

Portland General Electric Company (PGE) submits this filing pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 757.205 and 757.210, and Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 860-022-0025, for filing proposed tariff sheets associated with Tariff P.U.C. No. 18. PGE initially filed Advice No. 21-11 on April 29, 2021, with a requested effective date of June 2, 2021. PGE then submitted a Supplemental Filing on May 21, 2021 at the request of Staff to extend the effective date from June 2, 2021 to June 16, 2021. PGE submitted a Second Supplemental Filing on June 8, 2021 to extend the effective date from June 16, 2021 to June 30, 2021 at the request of Staff. PGE now submits this Third Supplemental Filing to extend the effective date from June 30, 2021 to July 28, 2021 to allow PGE more time for outreach to Stakeholders.

All sheets remain as previously filed.

To satisfy the requirements of OARs 860-022-0025(2), PGE provides the following response:

Schedule 55 does not increase, decrease, or otherwise change existing retail rates or have anything other than a de minimis impact on revenues.
