RE: Second Supplemental Filing of Advice No. 21-11 Schedule 55 Large Nonresidential Green Energy Affinity Rider (GEAR)

Portland General Electric Company (PGE) submits this filing pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 757.205 and 757.210, and Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 860-022-0025, for filing proposed tariff sheets associated with Tariff P.U.C. No. 18. PGE initially filed Advice No. 21-11 on April 29, 2021, with a requested effective date of June 2, 2021. PGE then submitted a Supplemental Filing on May 21, 2021 at the request of Staff to extend the effective date from June 2, 2021 to June 16, 2021. PGE now submits this Supplemental Filing to extend the effective date from June 16, 2021 to June 30, 2021 to allow Staff more time to review the filing.

All sheets remain as previously filed.

To satisfy the requirements of OARs 860-022-0025(2), PGE provides the following response:

Schedule 55 does not increase, decrease, or otherwise change existing retails rates or have anything other than a de minimis impact on revenues.

Due to the requested effective date and the less than 30-day notice, the application requesting a waiver of legal statutory notice, pursuant to ORS 757.220 and OAR 860-022-0020 that was submitted on May 21, 2021 is still valid.
