RE: Supplemental Filing of Advice No. 18-20, Schedule 106, Multnomah County Business Income Tax Update

Portland General Electric Company (PGE) submits this filing pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 757.205 and 757.210, and Oregon Administrative Rules (OARs) 860-022-0025(2) and 860-022-0030 for filing proposed tariff sheet associated with Tariff P.U.C. No. 18. PGE initially filed Advice No. 18-20 on November 9, 2018 with a requested effective date of January 1, 2019. PGE is submitting this Supplemental Filing at the request of Staff to allow more time for review. PGE now requests an effective date of February 1, 2019.

The Tariff sheet remains as previously filed.

To satisfy the requirements of OARs 860-022-0025(2) and 860-22-0030(1), PGE provides the following responses:

The proposed Schedule 106 rate change will result in a 0.187% overall rate increase for approximately 294,000 Multnomah County Customers. A typical Schedule 7 Residential Customer consuming 800 kWh monthly will see a bill increase of approximately \$0.17.
