RE: Supplemental Filing of Advice No. 21-32, Schedule 102 Regional Power Act Exchange Credit

Portland General Electric Company (PGE) submits this supplemental filing pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes 757.205 and 757.210, and Oregon Administrative Rules (OARs) 860-022-0025(2), and 860-022-0030 for filing proposed tariff sheet associated with Tariff P.U.C. No. 18. PGE initially filed Advice No. 21-32 on November 8, 2021 with a requested effective date of January 1, 2022, which remains as filed. PGE is submitting this Supplemental Filing to correct pages 5 through 11 of the work papers. The corrected work papers do not change the rate as filed in Schedule 102, however the correction does change the outcome of the increase impact Customers will see.

The Fourteenth Revision of Sheet No. 102-1 remains as previously filed.

To satisfy the requirements of OARs 860-022-0025(2), and 860-022-0030, PGE provides the following responses:

As a result of this proposed price change, customers will see an increase of \$7.4 million in their annual bills. This represents a lower credit to customers relative to the credit contained in current prices. A typical Schedule 7 Residential Customer consuming 780 kWh monthly will see a bill increase of approximately \$0.74 or 0.69%. PGE misstated this number in the prior letter.

Enclosed are the corrected work papers detailing the Schedule 102 bill comparisons.
