**RE: Supplemental Filing of Advice No. 22-25, Schedule 134 Gresham Retroactive
Privilege Tax Payment Adjustment Update**

Portland General Electric Company (PGE) submits this supplemental filing pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes 757.205 and 757.210, and Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 860-022-0025, for filing proposed tariff sheet associated with Tariff P.U.C. No. 18. PGE initially filed Advice No. 22-25 on October 26, 2022, with a requested effective date of January 1, 2023, which remains as filed. PGE is submitting this Supplemental Filing at the request of Staff correcting a transposed number in the work papers.

The sheet remains as filed.

To satisfy the requirements of OAR 860-022-0025, PGE responds as follows:

The proposed revision to Schedule 134 impacts approximately 48,500 City of Gresham customers. A typical Schedule 7 Residential customer consuming 780 kWh monthly will see a bill decrease of \$0.23 or 0.2%, inclusive of rate schedules to which Schedule 134 does not apply.
