RE: Supplemental Filing of Advice No. 22-32, Schedule 118 Income-Qualified Bill Discount Cost Recovery Mechanism Update

Portland General Electric Company (PGE) submits this supplemental filing pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes 757.205 and 757.210, and Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 860-022-0025, for filing proposed tariff sheet associated with Tariff P.U.C. No. 18. PGE initially filed Advice No. 22-32 on November 14, 2022, with a requested effective date of January 1, 2023, which remains as filed.

PGE is submitting this Supplemental Filing to correct an error in the Schedule 118 Income-Qualified Bill Discount bill comparison file, submitted as part of the price update filing on November 14, 2022. The bill comparison file shows customer bills for a range of usage levels under the current Schedule 118 prices and the proposed Schedule 118 prices. For non-residential customers, the \$1,000 cap on Schedule 118 charges is maintained with the proposed price change and requires a change to the usage threshold, from 4,347,826 kWh to 877,193 kWh per bill. The kWh threshold was not updated with the proposed price change in the bill comparison file, inadvertently indicating larger bill impacts for PGE's largest non-residential rate schedules (mainly Schedules 89 & 90).

The sheet remains as filed.

The correction did not affect PGE's responses in its initial Advice Filing on November 14, 2022, which requires PGE to satisfy the requirements of OAR 860-022-0025(2) and 860-022-0030.
