RE: Supplemental Filing of Advice No. 23-29, Schedule 152 Major Event Cost Recovery

Portland General Electric Company (PGE) submits this supplemental filing pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 757.205 and 757.210, Oregon Administrative Rules (OARs) 860-022-0025 and 860-022-0030 for filing proposed tariff sheets associated with Tariff P.U.C. No. 18. PGE initially filed Advice No. 23-29 on November 14, 2023, with a requested effective date of January 1, 2024, which remains as filed.

PGE is submitting this Supplemental Filing to update the workpapers filed with the initial filing on November 14<sup>th</sup> to correct for capital-associated amounts inadvertently included with the additional amounts related to the wildfire emergency event, as well as a correction to depreciation expense associated with these amounts. This reflects an immaterial change that does not impact the prices or tariff from the initial filing.

The tariff sheets remain as filed.

To satisfy the requirements of OARs 860-022-0025(2) and 860-022-0030, PGE provides the following responses:
