Portland General Electric Company (PGE) submits this filing pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 757.205 and 757.210, and Oregon Administrative Rules (OARs) 860-022-0025(2) and 860-022-0030 for filing proposed tariff sheet associated with Tariff P.U.C. No. 18. PGE initially filed Advice No. 18-20 on November 9, 2018 with a requested effective date of January 1, 2019. At the request of Staff to allow more time for review, PGE submitted a Supplemental Filing on December 10, 2018, to extend the effective date to February 1, 2019. PGE now submits this Second Supplemental Filing, again, at the request of Staff to resubmit the Tariff sheet updating the footer with the same effective date of February 1, 2019.

To satisfy the requirements of OARs 860-022-0025(2) and 860-22-0030(1), PGE provides the following responses:

The proposed Schedule 106 rate change will result in a 0.187% overall rate increase for approximately 294,000 Multnomah County Customers. A typical Schedule 7 Residential Customer consuming 800 kWh monthly will see a bill increase of approximately \$0.17.

Due to the less than 30-day notice and at the request of Staff to expedite for the public meeting on January 29, 2019, PGE is also submitting an application requesting a waiver of legal statutory notice, pursuant to ORS 757.220 and OAR 860-022-0020.



**SCHEDULE 106  
MULTNOMAH COUNTY BUSINESS INCOME TAX RECOVERY**

**PURPOSE**

To recover from Customers in Multnomah County the Multnomah County Business Income Tax (MCBIT) paid by the Company in accordance with Multnomah County Code § 12.610 and OAR 860-022-0045 and to establish an associated Automatic Adjustment Clause and balancing account.

**APPLICABLE**

All Customers receiving Electricity Service within Multnomah County.

**BALANCING ACCOUNT**

A MCBIT Balancing Account will be maintained to accrue any difference between the Company's actual local income tax liability and the amount collected from Customers under this Schedule. Any over or under-collection reflected in this account will be considered when the MCBIT Rate is established. This Balancing Account will accrue interest at the Commission-authorized rate for deferred accounts.

**MCBIT RATE DETERMINATION**

The MCBIT Rate is determined by dividing the sum of forecast MCBIT tax liability plus or minus any amount in the Balancing Account divided by forecast Retail Revenue from Customers in Multnomah County for each tax year or other applicable recovery period.

**MCBIT RATE**

The MCBIT Rate is:

0.214% of the total billed amount to the Customer excluding the Public Purpose Charge (Schedule 108), Energy Efficiency Funding Adjustment (Schedule 109), Low Income Assistance Charge (Schedule 115) and all other separately stated taxes. (I)
