No. 18. PGE initially filed Advice No. 19-07 on March 8, 2019 with a requested effective date of April 10, 2019 which remains as filed. PGE is submitting this Supplemental Filing to correct the following:

- Sheet No. 91-12 ~ The Option B new poles prices were inadvertently not included.
- Sheet No. 515-3 ~ Cobrahead has been renamed to Roadway LED.

To satisfy requirements under OAR 860-022-0025(2), PGE provides the following information:

This filing creates new service options for street and area lighting. Street and area light customers who choose Schedule 95 Option B, the new LED fixtures, or the new poles may see changes in their bill depending on the service selected. Because it is unknown how many customers will choose the new service options, any resulting revenue change is also unknown.

OAR 860-022-0030(1) does not apply because this filing is not proposing increased rates. The proposed rates are for new service options that are not currently available in the tariff.

Due to the requested effective date and the less than 30-day notice, PGE is also submitting an application requesting a waiver of legal statutory notice, pursuant to ORS 757.220 and OAR 860-022-0020.
