RE: Informational Update on Advice No. 19-13, Schedule 6 Residential Pricing Pilot

When PGE extended the Schedule 6 pilot term, in its June 2019 Advice Filing No. 19-13, PGE intended to time its expiration with the offering of a new Schedule 7 (residential service rate) time of use (TOU) rate design to provide a seamless transition from Schedule 6 to Schedule 7. Given the need for further work, the revised TOU rate design is not complete and the goal of providing a seamless experience for customers will not be achieved.

Schedule 6 expires September 30, 2019. PGE will send letters to participants, thanking them for their participation and advising them that they will be migrated to Schedule 7 basic service. In migrating customers to Schedule 7, PGE will not automatically enroll them in the current Schedule 7 TOU rate, to avoid customer confusion with multiple TOU designs.

After PGE's new Schedule 7 TOU rate design has been developed and approved, PGE will reach out to customers who had participated in Schedule 6 TOU to encourage them to enroll in the revised TOU.
