RE: Advice No. 2131 for Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink QC P.U.C. Oregon No. 33 Exchange and Network Services Tariff

Dear Commissioners:

On August 4, 2006, Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink submitted a filing to revise Lifeline tariff provisions in compliance with rule changes pursuant to FCC 15-71, adopted June 18, 2015. Lifeline rule changes became effective on February 17, 2016.

The filing also proposed to clarify and correct references, and standardize language regarding eligibility of Lifeline applicants who reside on federally recognized Tribal Lands. The revisions were administrative only and did not reflect changes in eligibility or benefits available to Tribal Lands applicants. Additionally, changes were proposed to facilitate a concurrence by CenturyTel of Oregon, Inc. and United Telephone Company of the Northwest, both d/b/a CenturyLink, with the provisions of Section 5.2.6, Telephone Assistance Programs.

CenturyLink now respectfully requests that this filing be withdrawn effective immediately.
