DISPOSITION: EXTENSION OF TARIFF FILINGS APPROVED

On June 12, 2000, U S WEST Communications, Inc. (USWC), filed for an extension of the effective dates of the following filings to January 31, 2001:

- Advice No. 1806 and Transmittal No. 99-014 PL, filed November 15, 1999, with a December 29, 1999, effective date;
- Advice No. 1806 and Transmittal No. 99-014 PL, Supplement No. 1, filed March 10, 2000, with a June 29, 2000, effective date; and
- Advice No. 1806 and Transmittal No. 99-014 PL, Supplement No. 2, filed April 14, 2000, with a June 29, 2000, effective date.

The filings above were filed in accordance with the UT 125 revenue requirement stipulated by USWC and the Oregon Public Utility Commission Staff, and are representative of USWC's rate design proposal to reduce overall revenues by \$64.2 million. USWC is requesting an extension in the effective dates to allow for the completion of the investigation of its rate design proposal.

That request should be approved.

IT IS ORDERED that USWC's request for an extension of the effective dates to January 31, 2001, for Advice No. 1806 and Transmittal No. 99-014 and Supplements No. 1 and 2 to that Advice and Transmittal, is approved.
