## DISPOSITION: STIPULATION ADOPTED

On December 15, 2000, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon filed a complaint against Defendant. The complaint charged Defendant with one violation of law and requested a penalty of \$1,000. On January 5, 2001, a copy of the complaint was served.

On January 8, 2001, the parties to this proceeding entered into a stipulation, which is attached and incorporated by reference.

Defendant admits committing the violation alleged in the complaint. The stipulation is adopted.

From the foregoing, it is concluded that no hearing is required. Under the terms of the stipulation, the allegations of the complaint are true, and Defendant has violated Oregon Administrative Rule(s) as alleged. Pursuant to the provisions of ORS 757.993, penalties should be assessed against Defendant under the terms and conditions of the stipulation.

#### **ORDER**

#### IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Civil monetary penalties shall be assessed against Defendant in the amount of \$1,000; and
- 2. Defendant shall pay the sum of \$200, due and payable within 30 days from the date of service of this order; and
- 3. Payment of the balance of the penalties (\$800) shall be suspended for a period of one year following entry of this order; and
- 4. Within 45 days following entry of this Order, Defendant shall arrange for a training session on Oregon excavation laws by contacting the Oregon Utility Notification Center (OUNC) Speakers Bureau.
- 5. Complainant may reopen this proceeding and petition for imposition of all or a portion of the suspended penalties if Defendant has not complied with all OUNC rules for a period of one year following entry of this order.

4	monet	ary penalties against the defendant in the amount of \$1000 under the following terms and		
5	condit	ions:		
6	A.	\$200 shall become due and payable on or before the 30th day following the		
7		Commission's entry of a final order in this case. Payment shall be by cashier's check or		
8	money order made out to the Public Utility Commission of Oregon, and the memo line of			
9		the cashier's check or money order shall state the "NC" docket number in the caption of		
10		this stipulation. Payment of the balance of the penalties (\$800) shall be suspended for a		
11		period of one year following the entry of the Commission's final order in this case. If		
12		defendant complies with all of the rules adopted by the Oregon Utility Notification		
13		Center (OUNC) under ORS 757.552 for that one year period, the suspended penalties		
14		(\$800) shall be dismissed and no further penalties shall be imposed for the violation		
15		alleged in the Complaint.		
16	B.	Within 45 days following entry of the Commission's final order, defendant shall		
17		arrange for a training session on Oregon excavation laws by contacting the OUNC		
18		Speakers Bureau.		
19	C.	In the event that complainant contends that the defendant has not complied with		
20		all OUNC rules for that one year period, complainant may reopen this proceeding and		
21		petition for imposition of all or a portion of the suspended penalties. In such case		
22		defendant shall be entitled to a hearing and to be notified of the basis upon which		
23		complainant contends that compliance has not occurred.
