DISPOSITION: STIPULATION ADOPTED

On March 6, 2001, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) filed a complaint against Defendant. The complaint charged Defendant with one violation of law and requested a penalty of \$1,000.

On March 13, 2001, a copy of the complaint was served. On March 19, 2001, the Commission received returned mail (of Complaint) from the Post Office stamped "Not Deliverable As Addressed, Unable to Forward, Return To Sender." The complaint was re-served on March 20, 2001.

On April 11, 2001, the parties to this proceeding entered into a stipulation, which is attached and incorporated by reference.

Defendant admits committing the violation alleged in the complaint. The stipulation is adopted.

From the foregoing, it is concluded that no hearing is required. Under the terms of the stipulation, the allegations of the complaint are true, and Defendant has violated Oregon Administrative Rule(s) as alleged. Pursuant to the provisions of ORS 757.993, penalties should be assessed against Defendant under the terms and conditions of the stipulation.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Civil monetary penalties shall be assessed against Defendant in the amount of \$1,000; and
- 2. Defendant shall pay the sum of \$200, due and payable within 30 days from the date of service of this order; and
- 3. Payment of the balance of the penalties (\$800) shall be suspended for a period of one year following entry of this order; and
- 4. Within 45 days following entry of this Order, Defendant shall arrange for a training session on Oregon excavation laws by contacting the Oregon Utility Notification Center (OUNC) Speakers Bureau.
- 5. Complainant may reopen this proceeding and petition for imposition of all or a portion of the suspended penalties if Defendant has not complied with all OUNC rules for a period of one year following entry of this order.

The parties further agree that the Commission may enter an order assessing civil monetary penalties against the defendant in the amount of \$1,000 under the following terms and conditions:

4.

5 A. \$200 shall become due and payable on or before the 30th day following the Commission's 6 entry of a final order in this case. Payment shall be by cashier's check or money order made 7 out to the **Public Utility Commission of Oregon**, and the memo line of the cashier's check 8 or money order shall state the "NC" docket number which is in the caption of this stipulation. 9 Payment of the balance of the penalties (\$800) shall be suspended for a period of one year 10 following the entry of the Commission's final order in this case. If defendant complies with 11 all of the rules adopted by the Oregon Utility Notification Center (OUNC) under ORS 12 757.552 for that one year period, the suspended penalties (\$800) shall be dismissed and no 13 further penalties shall be imposed for the violation alleged in the Complaint. 14 B. Within 45 days following entry of the Commission's final order, defendant shall contact the 15 OUNC Speakers Bureau to arrange for a training session on Oregon excavation laws. 16 C. In the event that complainant contends that the defendant has not complied with all OUNC 17 rules for that one year period, complainant may reopen this proceeding and petition for 18 imposition of all or a portion of the suspended penalties. In such case defendant shall be 19 entitled to a hearing and to be notified of the basis upon which complainant contends that

- 20 compliance has not occurred.
