ORDER

DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On March 15, 1999, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Ciera Network Systems Inc. ("Ciera") to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 99-209. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. In Ciera's 2000 Annual Report, Vince Vasquez, staff accountant for Ciera, noted that the certificate of authority for Ciera should be canceled. On March 12, 2001, the Commission cancelled Ciera's certificate of authority. *See* Order No. 01-222.

On March 22, 2001, Vince Vasquez filed a request to suspend Order No. 01-222, claiming the "Cancel Respondents Certificate" box was checked in error.

The information sent by Ciera indicated that it had not yet begun to do business in the state of Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of Ciera's certificate should be rescinded.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 01-222 canceling the certificate of authority of Ciera Network Systems Inc., is rescinded.
