**DISPOSITION: SUSPENSION EXTENDED**

On November 1, 2000, PacifiCorp filed Advice No. 00-015 to restructure and reprice its services in accordance with Senate Bill 1149, an electric industry restructuring bill passed by the 1999 Oregon Legislative Assembly. At its November 21, 2000 Public Meeting, the Commission found good cause to investigate the filing and suspended Advice No. 00-015 pursuant to ORS 757.215.

The suspension is due to expire August 31, 2001. However, by letter dated August 23, 2001, PacifiCorp agreed to a suspension of Advice No. 00-015 through September 7, 2001.

**ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED that Advice No. 00-015 filed by PacifiCorp on October 2, 2000, is suspended through September 7, 2001.
