DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On December 14, 1999, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Jefferey Stewart d/b/a Phone Connection (Phone Connection) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 99-757. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that Phone Connection failed to comply with Oregon Universal Service Fund requirements per ORS 759.425 and OAR 860-032-0008(2). At the November 6, 2001, public meeting, the Commission determined that Phone Connection's certificate of authority should be canceled. Phone Connection's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 01-959.

On January 3, 2002, Phone Connection filed a request to suspend Order No. 01-959, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that Phone Connection filed the requested information on January 2, 2002.

The information sent by Phone Connection to the Commission was late. However, the information has been received and it indicates Phone Connection is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of Phone Connection's certificate should be rescinded.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 01-959 canceling the certificate of authority of Jefferey Stewart d/b/a Phone Connection, is rescinded.
