At its November 20, 2001, public meeting, the Public Utility Commission opened a rulemaking proceeding docketed as AR 430 to consider adopting the 2002 edition of the National Electrical Safety Code and to make housekeeping changes to 860-024-0010.

On December 3, 2001, the Commission filed Notice of the Proposed Rulemaking with the Secretary of State and subsequently provided notice to all interested persons on the Commission's rule changes list.
