DISPOSITION: APPLICATION APPROVED;
TARIFFS ALLOWED TO GO INTO EFFECT

On January 24, 2002, Portland General Electric (PGE or Company) filed Advice No. 02-3 with the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) requesting implementation of a new Schedule 126 to allow the Company to begin amortizing a portion of its net variable power supply costs deferred under the mechanism previously approved at the February 20, 2001, public meeting. A description of the filing and procedural history is contained in the Staff's Report¹ and supporting attachments (*See Appendices A and B*).

At the public meeting on March 21, 2002, the Commission adopted Staff's recommendation to allow PGE's proposed tariff sheets to go into effect.
