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DISPOSITION: APPLICATION APPROVED

On March 11, 2002, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) received an application from Avista Utilities, proposing a rate decrease, effective April 2, 2002, along with an application for a LSN. The filing consisted of changes in purchased gas costs only. The filing requested an overall revenue decrease of 15.3%, or \$12.5 million annually.

Based on a review of the applications and the Commission's records, the Commission finds that the applications satisfy applicable statutes and administrative rules. At its public meeting on April 1, 2002, the Commission adopted Staff's recommendation to approve the applications. Staff's recommendation is attached as Appendix A and is incorporated by reference.

### **ORDER**

#### IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Avista's request for waiver of the 30-day notice requirement (LSN) is approved.
- 2. The amortization of deferred accounts, base gas cost changes, and rate changes requested in Docket No. UE 148 are effective as of April 2, 2002.
