DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On July 6, 2001, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to America's Digital Satelite Telephone, Inc. (ADST) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 01-568. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission.

The Commission's records had indicated that mail to the certificate holder was repeatedly returned and the certificate holder could not be located. At the March 21, 2002, public meeting, the Commission determined that ADST's certificate of authority should be canceled for failure to comply with OAR 860-032-0008(2). ADST's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 02-195.

On April 8, 2002, ADST filed a request to suspend Order No. 02-195, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that ADST filed the requested information on February 12, 2002, and confirmed on April 8, 2002, that no OUS reports are outstanding.

Under the circumstances, the cancellation of ADST's certificate should be rescinded.
