**DISPOSITION: APPLICATION APPROVED WITH CONDITIONS**

On June 3, 2002, Wagon Wheel Water Company Inc (Wagon Wheel) filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) pursuant to ORS 757.015, ORS 757.495 and OAR 860-027-0040, requesting authorization for Paul Rugloski Construction to provide construction services to Wagon Wheel.

Based on a review of the application and the Commission’s records, the Commission finds that the application satisfies applicable statutes and administrative rules. At its Public Meeting on June 18, 2002, the Commission adopted Staff’s recommendation with conditions. Staff’s recommendation report is attached as Appendix A, and is incorporated by reference.

**OPINION**

Under ORS 757.015, defining affiliated interest, Wagon Wheel and Paul Rugloski Construction are affiliated interests.

ORS 757.495 requires public utilities to seek approval of contracts with affiliated interests within 90 days after execution of the contract.

OAR 860-027-0040 specifies information regarding applications for approval of transactions between affiliated interests.

**ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED that the application of Wagon Wheel Water Company Inc, to enter into an affiliated interest transaction with Paul Rugloski Construction, is granted, subject to the conditions, as further stated in Appendix A.
