ORDER

DISPOSITION: TARIFF SHEETS FURTHER SUSPENDED

In separate filings, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) and Northwest Natural (NW Natural) submitted tariff sheets designed to decouple their respective companies' revenues from sales. The Commission suspended both filings for investigation pursuant to ORS 757.210 and ORS 757.215. *See* Order Nos. 01-750, 01-751 and 02-134. The current suspension period for both filings expires June 30, 2002.

PGE and NW Natural recently filed letters with the Commission agreeing to an extension of the respective suspension periods to August 15, 2002. *See* ORS 757.215(2).

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Advice No. 01-3, filed by Portland General Electric Company, and Advice No. 01-10, filed by Northwest Natural, are suspended for an additional period to August 15, 2002.
