DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

On December 22, 1999, CoreComm Oregon Inc. (CoreComm) was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. See Order No. 99-771.

In a letter dated April 11, 2002, Scott Kellogg of CoreComm, requested that the Commission cancel the certificate of authority for CoreComm. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority in Oregon for one or more days in 2002, it is required to file a form GRT and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by CoreComm Oregon Inc. should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by CoreComm Oregon Inc. is cancelled.
