DISPOSITION: SUSPENSION EXTENDED

On September 21, 2001, Pacific Power & Light filed tariff sheets in Advice No. 01-021 to be effective October 23, 2001. At its October 22, 2001, Public Meeting, the Commission found that good and sufficient cause existed to investigate the propriety and reasonableness of the tariff sheets pursuant to ORS 757.210 and 757.215. The Commission ordered suspension of the advice pending that investigation by Order No. 01-881.

The first suspension was due to expire on April 22, 2002. On April 8, 2002, the Commission issued Order No. 02-266 extending the suspension period until July 22, 2002.

The disposition of this docket is contingent on the Commission's action in UM 995, which order is expected to issue in mid to late July, 2002. PacifiCorp has requested that the Commission include UE 127 on the agenda for its August 6, 2002, public meeting. Because the meeting is after the suspension period expires in UE 127, by letter dated July 16, 2002, PacifiCorp agrees to extend the suspension period in UE 127 until August 7, 2002, to accommodate this schedule.
