DISPOSITION: ORDER NO. 02-469 AMENDED

On July 18, 2002, the Commission issued Order No. 02-469 adopting the Stipulation between PacifiCorp and Commission Staff as the resolution of the matters in these dockets. We note that a number on page 4 of that order, in the paragraph beginning "**The Stipulation**," is incorrect. The number occurs in the following paragraph:

The Stipulation. The Stipulation between Staff and PacifiCorp provides for a disallowance of 15 percent of the excess net power costs incurred during the deferral period. The Stipulation presents a formula for determining prudently incurred excess net power costs. As a result of applying the formula, the amount requested for deferral in this proceeding is reduced to \$130,048,750. After taking into account carrying charges and amortization through

December 2001, the remaining amount for which recovery is sought is \$119,908,152.

The number \$130,048,750 is incorrect. The correct amount requested for deferral in this proceeding is \$130,960,825. See PacifiCorp/Staff Exhibit 102. The paragraph is amended to read:

The Stipulation. The Stipulation between Staff and PacifiCorp provides for a disallowance of 15 percent of the excess net power costs incurred during the deferral period. The Stipulation presents a formula for determining prudently incurred excess net power costs. As a result of applying the formula, the amount requested for deferral in this proceeding is reduced to \$130,960,825. After taking into account carrying charges and amortization through December 2001, the remaining amount for which recovery is sought is \$119,908,152.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 02-469 is amended as described above.
