Portland General Electric (PGE) previously submitted tariff sheets designed to decouple its revenues from sales. The Commission suspended the filing for investigation pursuant to ORS 757.210 and ORS 757.215. The current suspension period expires August 15, 2002.

On August 5, 2002, PGE filed a letter with the Commission agreeing to an extension of the suspension period until September 16, 2002. See ORS 757.215(2).

IT IS ORDERED that Advice No. 01-3, filed by Portland General Electric, is suspended for an additional period until September 16, 2002.
