**DISPOSITION: APPLICATION GRANTED**

On March 18, 2002, Qwest Corporation (Qwest) filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission), pursuant to ORS 759.560 and OAR 860-025-0027, requesting an order transferring rights to allocated territory to Clear Creek Mutual Telephone Company (Clear Creek). The purpose of the proposed transfer is to allow Clear Creek to provide telecommunications service to Hidden Lake Estates, a new housing development that straddles the current exchange boundary line between Qwest's Oregon City exchange and Clear Creek's Redland exchange.

Clear Creek has agreed to serve the entire Hidden Lake Estates development and has requested the proposed transfer. It plans to reinforce its existing facilities in the area to serve the new development. Since Qwest would be required to build new facilities to serve only nine lots in the new housing development, it has agreed to the transfer. Currently, Qwest has no equipment or facilities in the area to be transferred. As such, no Qwest customers are impacted by the transfer.

There is no revenue impact associated with the proposed transfer. It does not involve any LATA boundary and there is no effect on EAS or toll routes. The Staff of the Public Utility Commission has reviewed the application and recommends approval.

Based on the foregoing, the Commission finds that the application is in the public interest and should be granted. Appendix A of this order is a metes and bounds description of the property to be transferred. Appendix B shows the modified Oregon City exchange to be served by Qwest. Appendix C is the modified Redland exchange to be served by Clear Creek.

**ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED that the application filed by Qwest Corporation to transfer rights to allocated territory to Clear Creek Mutual Telephone Company is approved. Both Qwest and Clear Creek shall file revised exchange maps within 30 days of the date of this order.
