ORDER

DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On January 30, 2001, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Local Telcom Holdings, LLC (Local) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 01-143. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that Local failed to file an annual report for the year 2001 as required by OAR 860-032-0060(2)(a). On May 23, and June 18, 2002, the Commission notified Local that the report had not been received. At the July 23, 2002, public meeting, the Commission determined that Local's certificate of authority should be canceled. Local's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 02-529.

On August 26, 2002, Local filed a request to suspend Order No. 02-529, claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that Local filed the requested information on August 26, 2002.

The information sent by Local to the Commission was late. However, the information has been received and it indicates Local is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of Local's certificate should be rescinded.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 02-529 canceling the certificate of authority of Local Telecom Holdings, LLC is rescinded.
