ORDER

DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On February 22, 2001, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Morgan Enterprises I LLC (Morgan I) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 01-188. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. After investigation, the Commission found that Morgan I failed to file an annual report for the year 2001 as required by OAR 860-032-0060(2)(a). On May 23, and June 18, 2002, the Commission notified Morgan I that the report had not been received. At the July 23, 2002, public meeting, the Commission determined that Morgan I's certificate of authority should be canceled. Morgan I's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 02-530.

On October 1, 2002, Morgan I filed a request to suspend Order No. 02-530 claiming that it had complied with the Commission's rules and regulations. A review of the Commission's records indicates that Morgan I filed the requested information on September 27, 2002.

The information sent by Morgan I to the Commission was late. However, the information has been received and it indicates Morgan I is providing telecommunications service in Oregon. Under the circumstances, the cancellation of Morgan I's certificate should be rescinded.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 02-530 canceling the certificate of authority of Morgan Enterprises I LLC, is rescinded.
