DISPOSITION: CANCELLATION ORDER RESCINDED

On September 24, 1999, the Commission granted a certificate of authority to Telecommunications Cooperative Network Inc. (TCN) to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 99-563. Oregon telecommunications providers are required to provide requested information to the Commission. On September 10, 2002, TCN filed a letter informing the Commission that TCN will cease service as of October 3, 2002. On September 12, 2002, TCN's certificate of authority was canceled in Order No. 02-635.

On December 2, 2002, TCN filed a request to rescind Order No. 02-635. TCN informed the Commission that although its September 10 letter stated that it was discontinuing service to its customers in Oregon, it intended to discontinue only one of its service offerings and the letter was only providing an update to the Commission of its current activities, not requesting that its certificate of authority be canceled.

Under the circumstances, the cancellation of TCN's certificate should be rescinded.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Order No. 02-635 canceling the certificate of authority of Telecommunications Cooperative Network Inc. is rescinded.
