On April 6, 2001, the Commission entered Order No. 01-272 adopting Staff's recommendation that Qwest Corporation's (Qwest) statutory service quality penalties for the year 2000 be directed to the targeted investment of replacing all analog carrier systems within Qwest's Oregon territory.

On November 21, 2002, Staff filed a report and a motion to close this docket. According to Staff, Qwest has met the conditions delineated in Order No. 01-272. Therefore, Staff contends, there is no longer a reason to hold this matter open.
