## DISPOSITION: INVESTIGATION OPENED

On October 4, 2002, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) opened an investigation to consider regulatory policy pertaining to new generating resources. This investigation is an outgrowth of Docket AR 417, which involved proposed rules for ratemaking treatment of new generating resources. The Commission wishes to discuss the issues involved in market stability and new resources in an investigative proceeding with workshops.

Staff is to organize workshops to cover the following:

- 1. How should new generating resources be treated for rate-making?
- 2. In planning for new resources, which customers should the plan be designed to include?
- 3. In determining a resource acquisition policy, should competitive bidding occur, and if so, to what extent?

At the conclusion of the workshops, the Commission will provide a policy direction for the ratemaking treatment of new generating resources.
