DISPOSITION: TARIFF SHEETS SUSPENDED

At the August 20, 2002, Regular Public Meeting, pursuant to ORS 759.180 and 759.185, the Commission voted to suspend for investigation the tariff sheets filed by Centurytel of Oregon, Inc., in Advice No. 237. The suspension was for a period not to exceed six months from August 21, 2002, the effective date of the tariff sheets. *See* Order No. 02-564.

We have determined that more time is needed to properly complete our investigation. Therefore, pursuant to ORS 759.185(1), we order the suspension period extended for an additional three month period from February 20, 2003, the last day of the initial suspension.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Advice No. 237 filed by CENTURYTEL OF OREGON, INC., is suspended for a period of time not to exceed three months from February 20, 2003.
