**DISPOSITION: APPLICATION DISMISSED**

On March 21, 2000, Sun Glo Water Company, Inc. (Sun Glo), filed an application with the Commission for allocation of exclusive service territory. In response to the requisite notice of the application, the City of Grants Pass requested a hearing on this matter on March 2, 2001. A public comment hearing and prehearing conference was held in Grants Pass, Oregon, on April 26, 2001. A schedule was set at the conference, including a settlement conference on July 2, 2001.

After the settlement conference, Sun Glo agreed to subject its application to the City's final plat agreement. Commission Staff and the City of Grants Pass agreed that the City would withdraw its request for a hearing because Sun Glo's customers would eventually be served by the City of Grants Pass.

The City of Grants Pass sent the Commission a letter dated March 14, 2003, stating that all homes previously served by Sun Glo are now served by the City of Grants Pass Water Distribution System. On March 19, 2003, Commission Staff filed a memorandum with the Hearings Division asking that this application be dismissed and the docket closed.

On review of this docket, we conclude that Staff's recommendation should be adopted.

**ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED that the application of Sun Glo Water Company, Inc., for allocation of exclusive service territory is dismissed and this docket is closed.
