DISPOSITION: MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO MAKE COMPLIANCE FILING AND REFUNDS GRANTED
In Order No. 03-171, entered March 21, 2003, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) ordered that Qwest Corporation (Qwest) must refund certain nonrecurring charges collected from competitive telecommunications carriers by June 13, 2003. In Order No. 03-209, entered April 9, 2003, the Commission also ruled that Qwest shall submit a revised compliance filing on May 9, 2003.
Subsequent to the Commission's orders, the parties agreed that Qwest's compliance filing could be postponed until May 12, 2003. On May 2, 2003, Qwest filed a motion requesting that the date to file refunds be extended until July 15, 2003. Qwest affirms that it will continue to pay interest at the 8.77% annual rate ordered by the Commission. Qwest's motion is unopposed.
IT IS ORDERED that:
 Qwest shall submit the compliance filing required by Order No. 03-209, no later than May 12, 2003, and;
2. Qwest shall make the refunds required by Order No. 03-171, no later than July 15, 2003.
