DISPOSITION: CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY CANCELLED

On April 17, 2003, Deseret Telecommunications Network Inc. (Deseret) was granted a certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon as a competitive provider. *See* Order No. 03-231.

In a letter dated June 13, 2003, Eric Edwards of Deseret, informed the Commission that the company will not be providing long distance or any other type of telecommunications service in Oregon. He requested the company's certificate of authority be cancelled. The company is reminded that because it had a certificate of authority in Oregon for one or more days in 2003, it is required to file a Form GRT and pay a minimum of \$100 for that year.

In view of the foregoing, the certificate of authority to provide telecommunications service in Oregon held by Deseret Telecommunications Network Inc. should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of authority held by Deseret Telecommunications Network Inc. is cancelled.
