DISPOSITION: STIPULATION ADOPTED

On May 3, 2003, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon filed a complaint against Defendant. The complaint charged Defendant with 27 violations of law and requested a penalty of \$175,000. On May 9, 2003, a copy of the complaint was served

On May 25, 2003, the parties to this proceeding entered into a stipulation, which is attached as Appendix A.

Defendant admits committing the violations alleged in the complaint. The stipulation is adopted.

From the foregoing, it is concluded that no hearing is required. Under the terms of the stipulation, the allegations of the complaint are true, and Defendant has violated Oregon Administrative Rules as alleged. Pursuant to the provisions of ORS 757.993, penalties should be assessed against Defendant under the terms and conditions of the stipulation.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Civil monetary penalties shall be assessed against Defendant in the amount of \$175,000 for 27 violations of law.

2. Defendant shall

- A. Pay the sum of \$15,000 to become due and payable on or before the 30th day following the Commission's entry of a final order in this case.
- B. Payment shall be by <u>cashier's check or money order</u> made out to the **Public Utility Commission of Oregon**, and the <u>memo line of the</u> <u>cashier's check or money order shall state the "NC" docket number</u> in the caption of this stipulation. Payment of the balance of the penalties (\$20,000) shall be in accord with the following schedule:

\$4,000	On or before July 1, 2003
\$4,000	August 1, 2003
\$4,000	September 1, 2003
\$4,000	October 1, 2003
\$4,000	November 1, 2003

In the alternative, defendant may pay \$33,000 on or before the 30th day following the Commission's entry of a final order in this case.

3. If Defendant has not paid the amount assessed in accord with the schedule in paragraph 2 above or within 30 days from the date of service of this order, then Defendant shall pay the amount assessed in paragraph 1 above (\$175,000). Such payment shall be due immediately following the expiration of the time period set out in paragraph 2 above.
