ORDER

DISPOSITION: STIPULATION ADOPTED

On June 12, 2003, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon filed a complaint against Defendant. The complaint charged Defendant with one violation of law. Defendant committed the violation described in this complaint within one year from the date a prior order was issued. *See* Order No. 00-720. A penalty shall be imposed in the amount of \$5,000 for each violation alleged, and the \$800 penalty that was suspended in Order No. 00-720 entered against Defendant shall be reinstated, for a total penalty of \$5,800. On June 23, 2003, a copy of the complaint was served.

On June 26, 2003, the parties to this proceeding entered into a stipulation, which is attached as Appendix A.

Defendant admits committing the violation alleged in the complaint. The stipulation is adopted.

From the foregoing, it is concluded that no hearing is required. Under the terms of the stipulation, the allegations of the complaint are true, and Defendant has violated Oregon Administrative Rule(s) as alleged. Pursuant to the provisions of ORS 757.993, penalties should be assessed against Defendant under the terms and conditions of the stipulation.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Civil monetary penalties shall be assessed against Defendant in the amount of \$5,000 for one violation of law.
2. Payment of the balance of the penalties (\$800) from Order No. 00-720 entered against Defendant shall be reinstated.
3. Defendant:
 - (a) shall pay the sum of \$1,800, due and payable within 30 days from the date of service of this order.
 - (b) shall contact the OUNC Speakers Bureau and attend a training session on Oregon excavation laws within 30 days following entry of the Commission's final order.
4. Payment of the balance of the penalties (\$4,000) shall be suspended, unless Defendant fails to comply with paragraph 3 above or a showing is made that Defendant has violated, within one year of the date of this order, any rules administered by the Oregon Utility Notification Center.
5. If Defendant has not paid the amount assessed in paragraph 3(a) above within 30 days from the date of service of this order, then Defendant shall pay the amount assessed in paragraph 1 above (\$5,800). Such payment shall be due immediately following the expiration of the time period set out in paragraph 3(a) above.

STIPULATION FOR ENTRY OF FINAL ORDER

The Public Utility Commission of Oregon, appearing by and through Paul A. Graham, Assistant Attorney General, and James Drayton, the defendant herein, hereby stipulate as follows:

1.

A Complaint in this case is pending before the Commission charging the defendant with one violation of law, as set out in the attached Complaint on file herein.

2.

Both parties to this proceeding are willing to forego further processing of that Complaint and further are willing to resolve this matter on the basis of this stipulation.

3.

The defendant admits that the violation was committed as alleged in the Complaint and is willing for the Commission to enter an order finding that the violation was committed as alleged in the Complaint.

4.

The parties further agree that the Commission may enter an order assessing civil monetary penalties against the defendant in the amount of \$5,800 (\$800 of penalties from

Final Order No. 00-720 and \$5,000 in penalties from a subsequent violation of August 27, 2001)

1 under the following terms and conditions:

2 A. \$800 shall become due and payable on or before the 30th day following the
3 Commission's entry of a final order in this case.

4 B. Payment shall be by cashier's check or money order made out to the **Public**
5 **Utility Commission of Oregon**, and the *memo line of the cashier's check or money*
6 *order shall state the "NC" docket number* in the caption of this stipulation. Payment of
7 the balance of the penalties (\$4,000) shall be suspended for a period of one year
8 following the entry of the Commission's final order in this case. If defendant complies
9 with all of the rules adopted by the Oregon Utility Notification Center (OUNC) under
10 ORS 757.552 for that one year period, the suspended penalties (\$4,000) shall be
11 dismissed and no further penalties shall be imposed for the violation alleged in the
12 Complaint.

13 C. Within 30 days following entry of the Commission's final order, defendant shall
14 contact the OUNC Speakers Bureau and attend a training session on Oregon excavation
15 laws.

16 D. In the event that complainant contends that the defendant has not complied with
17 all OUNC rules for that one year period, complainant may reopen this proceeding and
18 petition for imposition of all or a portion of the suspended penalties. In such case
19 defendant shall be entitled to a hearing and to be notified of the basis upon which
20 complainant contends that compliance has not occurred.
